College is an investment in your future, for which you should start planning now. Fortunately, the cost of attending an Oklahoma state college or university is among the lowest in the nation, and many sources of financial aid are available to help manage the cost.

As you might imagine, various factors can affect college expenses, including the type of college or university, the number of courses a student takes, the student's major, and his or her personal lifestyle. One way to prepare for the cost is for you and your parents to begin saving for college as soon as possible because the more you save, the less money you'll need to find when you start college.

2016-2017 Estimated Costs for Resident Students at Oklahoma Public Colleges and Universities

The average estimated cost of attending Oklahoma colleges and universities is calculated below for full-time **resident** undergraduate students enrolled in 30 semester credit hours during the 2017-18 academic year. Costs for room and board and books and supplies are based on Fiscal Year 2016 estimated costs and may be rounded to the nearest dollar. **Oklahoma Public Colleges and Universities Tuition
& Mandatory Fees Per Credit Hour for 2017-18**

The cost of a college or university course is determined by the number of credit hours awarded for completing the class. Usually, one credit hour represents one hour of in-class instruction per week for 16 weeks in a specific subject. Therefore, the cost for one course is determined by multiplying the number of credit hours the class is worth by the total tuition and mandatory fees per credit hour.
