



## What is College App Week?

College Application Week (CAW) is a concentrated effort to give all high school seniors the opportunity to apply to one or more colleges while at their high school, technology center, library or community center, with knowledgeable volunteers available to help them through the application process.

CAW is part of an initiative sponsored by the Kresge Foundation, the Lumina Foundation and the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation for the American Council on Education. It is endorsed on the state level by public higher education Chancellor Allison Garrett, the Oklahoma State Department of Education and the Oklahoma State Chamber.

## When is College App Week?

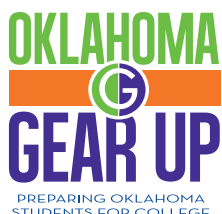
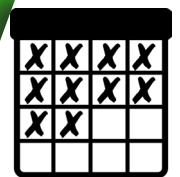
This year, Oklahoma's CAW will be held Sept. 26-30, to better accommodate the FAFSA filing date of Oct. 1.
