The FAFSA is:

A free application for federal student aid

A free application for some types of Oklahoma aid

Required for Oklahoma's Promise

The key to unlocking money for college

A statement of your family's income from a prior year

Federal financial aid is available at many types of schools: career technology centers, community colleges, universities and graduate schools.

The FAFSA isn't:

A college application

A student loan application

Available only to students with great grades

A commitment to accept any type of financial aid

A credit check



low-interest student loans.

You do not have to report your grade point average (GPA).

While there are some basi requirements to be eligible for federal student aid, your age and ethnicity are not considered.

Scholarships come from other sources and need to be applied for separately.

Complete your FAFSA by going to Student Aid.gov or downloading the myStudentAid mobile app.

The FAFSA isn't a one-time thing. You'll need to submit one each year you need money for college.

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
