



What is College App Week?

College Application Week (CAW) is a concentrated effort to give all high school seniors the opportunity to apply to one or more colleges while at their high school, technology center, library or community center, with knowledgeable volunteers available to help them through the application process.

CAW is part of an initiative sponsored by the Kresge Foundation, the Lumina Foundation and The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation for the American Council on Education. It's endorsed on the state level by public higher education Chancellor Glen D. Johnson, the Oklahoma State Department of Education and the Oklahoma State Chamber.

If you plan to hold a CAW event, you'll need to register at OKCollegeAppWeek.org.



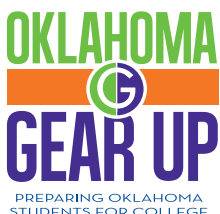
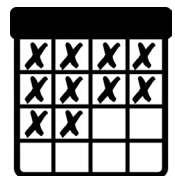
When is College App Week?

This year, Oklahoma's CAW will be held September 20-24.



What if September 20-24 doesn't fit into my school's schedule?

You can choose any week during the fall 2021 semester to hold your CAW events. Just tell us the date(s) you plan to hold your event when you submit your registration at OKCollegeAppWeek.org.



Do my school's CAW activities have to cover a whole week?

No. The most important objective of CAW is scheduling one or more days during the week for students to have computer access for applying to college. Other activities throughout the week help to build excitement and student involvement.

Start planning now! Once you've established the dates, enlist the help of knowledgeable volunteers who'll work with students individually as they're completing college applications.
